Financing Options

If you cannot pay your bill on the first day of classes, the Student Accounts Office will automatically enroll you in the Installment Payment Plan. Under this plan, a 1% finance charge is assessed on the last day of each month on any unpaid balance. Students are required to pay monthly installments following receipt of the initial billing summary. It is highly recommended that 1/3 of the initial billing summary be paid in the first month; 1/3 of the remaining balance paid in the second month, and the balance in full paid in the third month.
