Representative Sampling of January and Summer Term Courses

Short-term programs often are a good way to get a "taste" of study abroad or a good fit in a tight academic schedule. Courses are offered during January, summer terms, or embedded within a term. Short-term programs typically run from 2 - 10 weeks and grant between 4 and 8 CSC credits.

Approximately 30 courses are offered each January. St. Catherine faculty typically offer two to three Global Search for Justice courses abroad each year during January or summer. Many other programs are available through affiliated institutions and universities.
