



Webmail on Internet Explorer 7 (Windows Vista) or Safari (Mac OS)

St. Kate's Webmail is not compatible with either Internet Explorer 7 for Windows Vista or Safari for Mac OS. You must either switch to the webmail client or Mozilla Firefox internet browser.

To switch to the webmail client:

- Log in to your St. Kate's email, either through KateWay or through the direct webpage.
- You will be redirected to a loading page. Click the link that says 'Click here to set your default mail client'.

- **Username:** Typically, *First Initial, Middle Initial, Last Name*, all lower-case, with no spaces. Example: Maggie Jo Simpson = **mjsimpson**
- **New student password:** St. Catherine ID number plus the last four digits of your social security number.
- **Note:** Your browser must be set to accept cookies for the authentication procedure to be successful.

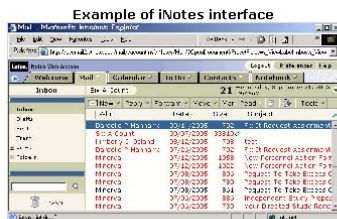

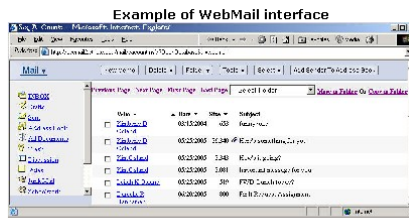

Example of iNotes interface

- Requires IE 6.x, cookies, ActiveX controls, JavaScript
- Turn off all pop-up blockers
- Must click YES for all Security Warnings from IBM



Example of WebMail interface

- Requires cookies, Java, JavaScript
- Turn off all pop-up blockers
- Must click YES for all Security Warnings from IBM

- Select 'WebMail', then 'Submit'. Now you have switched the webmail client.
