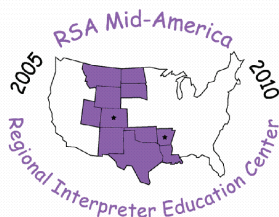

Instructional Program & Activities

Assessments will be conducted to identify areas for growth, and provide you with valuable feedback.

The morning sessions consist of classroom instruction on ASL Linguistics, and medical and technical terminology and classifiers. Afternoon sessions will feature fun activities with Deaf mentors; including visiting the Minneapolis Institute of Arts, a trip to the Mall of America, and a visit to the zoo.
