

## What to Bring When You Move Onto Campus

### Be sure to pack ...

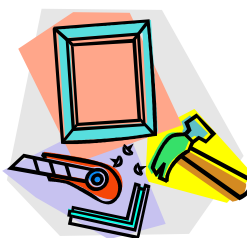
- Comforter, blanket, pillow, extra blanket
- Sheets (normal twin size), pillowcases, mattress pad
- Alarm clock
- Stereo/radio, favorite CDs
- Power strips, surge protector
- Computer/ Laptop (Residence Halls do have computer labs! See computer recommendations below.)
- TV/ VCR/ DVD player
- Cable hookup (cable service is provided, but you must provide your own connection from TV to wall)
- Laundry soap, stain stick, bleach, fabric softener, dryer sheets
- Laundry basket/ bag
- Towels, washcloths
- Shower caddy
- Soap dish, toothbrush holder, cup
- Bathrobe, slippers, shower shoes
- Personal items (Shampoo, soap, tooth paste, toothbrush, etc.)
- Desk Lamp/ clip-on bed lamp
- Daily Planner/ wall calendar
- Office supplies (stapler, paper clips, file folders, three-hole punch, etc.)
- Desk Organizer, Pen/ Pencil holder
- Blue Painter's Tape (see box on right)
- School Supplies (pens, pencils, highlighters, paper, notebooks, folders, etc.)
- Backpack/ book bag

- Organizer/ filing cabinet
- Storage boxes/ crates (stackable)
- Message board with markers (wet or dry erase)
- Transportation (Bicycle, rollerblades, etc.)
- Plants
- Posters/ decorations to personalize room
- Pictures of family and friends
- Shoe organizer
- Clothes hangers
- Umbrella/ rain coat
- Winter boots, hat, mittens, etc.
- Swim suit/ beach towel
- Workout clothes
- Snacks
- Cooking pot/pan
- Small dish soap
- Plate, bowl, cup, utensils (more than one set)
- Flashlight
- Small tool kit
- First-Aid Kit (band-aids)
- Refrigerator (less than 3.5 cubic ft.)
- Carpet/ rug(s)
- Fan
- Camera, film
- Dictionary, Thesaurus
- Postage Stamps (Students receive mail at campus post office.)



### What NOT to Bring...

- Quarters for Laundry Machines (Laundry cards will be sold to students to use the machines. Students can put money on the card when necessary.)
- Wastebasket
- Candles, incense
- Toaster, microwave or hotplates (Microwaves in the form of combination microwave/refrigerator units rented from Collegiate Services are allowed.)
- Waterbeds, tanning beds
- Air conditioning units
- Halogen lights
- Pets (fish are allowed)
- Everything that currently occupies your room
- All your clothes and shoes (Do not bring what you might wear!)
- Answering machine (Students have voicemail)
- Your own lofting equipment



#### Painter's Tape

Want to hang stuff up on the wall of your room? We don't recommend using 3M hooks, scotch tape, masking tape or silly putty. Instead, our professional painters recommend 3M painters tape that is specifically designed for "Delicate Surfaces". This is a recommendation, and use of any type of adhesive at your discretion; any damage to walls is the responsibility of the resident.

**A final note:** Remember, space is limited so some larger items may be better shared among roommates. Be sure that you only bring what you really NEED! If you are not sure, leave it at home and see if you can live without it.
